- All garbage and recycling carts must be placed at the curb before 6:00am on your service day.
- Set carts 3 feet apart and 6 feet away from vehicles and fences.
- Push carts to the outside on scheduled pick-up day. Lid openings should face the street.
- Do not overfill carts. Lids should close.

Cal Recycle SB 1383 Update

- ❑ New Effective Date: January 1st, 2022
- ❑ Requires California to recover 20% of currently disposed edible food by 2025.
- ❑ Jurisdictions are required to:
 - ❑ Provide organics collection service to all residents
 - ❑ Establish Edible Food Recovery Program
 - ❑ Conduct Education & Outreach to Community
 - ❑ Monitor compliance & conduct enforcement
