A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF COALINGA DESIGNATING NON-SWORN PUBLIC SAFETY EMPLOYEES AS MEMBERS OF THE PUBLIC SAFETY NON-SWORN EMPLOYEE BARGAINING UNIT

THAT WHEREAS, the City of Coalinga desires to remove non-sworn police technicians as members of the Coalinga Police Officers Association and designate them as members of a new unit titled the Public Safety Non-Sworn Employee Bargaining Unit; and

WHEREAS, City Staff has met and consulted with representatives from the Coalinga Police Officers Association regarding the designation and did not receive any response; and

WHEREAS, non-sworn Fire Department employees are not yet members of any bargaining unit; and

WHEREAS, it is beneficial and reasonable for Police Technicians I-III, Non-Safety Emergency Medical Technicians and Non-Safety Paramedics to be members of the same bargaining unit as they share a community interest;

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that the City hereby creates a new bargaining unit which shall be known as the Public Safety Non-Sworn Employee Bargaining Unit; and

NOW THEREFORE BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the following positions shall be designated as members of the Public Safety Non-Sworn Employee Bargaining Unit:

Police Technicians I-III Non-Safety Emergency Medical Technicians Non-Safety Paramedics

NOW THEREFORE BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the City Manager is hereby authorized to sign all necessary documents to accomplish said designation.
