PROPOSAL INTENT

The City of Coalinga seeks proposals from qualified vendors for the design and delivery of shade structures for Centennial and Sandalwood parks located in Coalinga, CA 93210. One (1) shade structure is needed at each park. Installation of the shade structures will be performed by City Contractor as part of the City's Park Exercise Equipment project which includes construction of connecting sidewalks, perimeter curb, poured in place rubber surfacing, and outdoor exercise equipment at the two parks. Shade structures are to be delivered to City of Coalinga Public Works Department, 135 E. Sacramento Street, Coalinga, CA 93210.

While the primary design specification calls out rectangular and square hip shelters, the city would also like to receive alternate design proposals that fit the site conditions and use. The focus shall remain in providing shade for the users of the new outdoor exercise equipment area being constructed by others. Examples of alternate designs may be those with multiple canopy structures, layered sails, or 4 point hypar sails.

Preliminary site plans for both Centennial and Sandalwood Parks are included as Attachment 1 of this RFP. No site visit is required, and no pre-bid meeting will be held.

SCOPE OF WORK

The selected vendor shall perform the following services to provide one (1) shade structure for Centennial Park and one (1) shade structure for Sandalwood Park once awarded:

- 1. Submit shop drawings and product specifications for proposed structure and all accessories for review and approval to include:
 - a. Plans, elevations, and sections showing all sides of the proposed structure
 - b. Structural calculations and footing details
 - c. Installation instructions
 - d. Design signed and sealed by a licensed Engineer
- 2. Work with City of Coalinga to finalize materials, finishes and colors.
- 3. Deliver complete shade structure to City of Coalinga Public Works Yard, 135 E. Sacramento Street, Coalinga, CA 93210.

SPECIFICATIONS

- 1. Primary basis of design shall be rectangular or square hip canopy.
 - a. 10' entry height
 - b. (4) steel columns conforming to ASTM standards, factory welded and watertight.
 - c. High density polyethylene (HDPE) shade fabric
 - d. Drilled pier footing
 - e. Color
 - a. Fabric: rainforest green or equivalent.
 - b. Frame: rainforest green or equivalent
 - f. Dimensions
 - a. Centennial Park: 30'x44' (may vary)
 - b. Sandalwood Park: 36'x36' (may vary)
- 2. Deviations from rectangular or square hip canopy may be accepted in the alternate designs

- 2. Clarifications requested by vendors must be in writing and must be received not less than 72 hours before the submission deadline. The reply will be in the form of an addendum, a copy of which will be provided in writing to all known proposers who received the original RFP.
- 3. Any verbal communications are non-binding.

EVALUATION/ACCEPTANCE

After the submission deadline, City of Coalinga Public Works Department staff as well as City Engineer will review and evaluate the proposals based on the following:

- 1. Responsiveness to the RFP and criteria
- 2. Design and Aesthetics
- 3. Quality and Warranty
- 4. Overall Cost
- 5. Product availability and lead times

Based on the proposal evaluations, the Public Works Department staff and City Engineer will make Proposer/design recommendations to the City of Coalinga City Council. The City Council will make the final determination at the October 6th, 2022 meeting and an agreement will be negotiated with the selected Proposer. The City reserves the right to make minor changes to the selected design within the scope and budget with the selected Proposer. RFP outcome will be released following City Council decision.

TERMS AND CONDITIONS

- 1. Late proposals cannot be accepted.
- 2. Proposals shall be valid for a minimum period of (60) days from submission deadline.
- 3. Proposals may be modified or withdrawn by an authorized representative of the vendor by formal written notice prior to the submission deadline.
- 4. The contents of any proposal received shall become the contractual obligations upon the execution of a contract by authorized representatives of both the City and the Proposer. Failure of the successful Proposer to accept these obligations my result in cancellation of the award.
- 5. This RFP does not commit the City to enter into a contract.
- 6. The City reserves the right to reject any and all proposals, and to waive minor irregularities in any proposal.
- 7. The City reserves the right to select any proposal when such action is considered to be in the best interest of the City.
- 8. The City reserves the right to accept other than the lowest offer.
- 9. The City reserves the right to exercise discretion and apply its judgement with respect to selection of any proposals submitted.
- 10. The City reserves the right to request clarification of information submitted, and to request additional information from any proposer.
- 11. The City shall not be responsible for any costs incurred by the firm in preparing, submitting, responding to requests for clarifications or additional information, or presenting its response to the RFP.

GENERAL NOTES

- 1. NO CONSTRUCTION SHALL BE STARTED WITHOUT PLANS APPROVED BY THE CITY OF COALINGA PUBLIC WORKS DEPARTMENT
- 2. THE CONTRACTOR SHALL ATTEND A PRE-CONSTRUCTION MEETING WITH THE CITY OF COALINGA'S REPRESENTATIVE PRIOR TO COMMENCEMEN AND WILL BE AT THE CONTRACTOR'S RISK.
- WORK SHALL BE SUBJECT TO THE APPROVAL OF THE DESIGN ENGINEER. A COPY OF THE CITY OF COALINGA STANDARDS MAY BE PURCHASED AT CITY HALL.
- 4. THE CONSTRUCTION CONTRACTOR SHALL MAINTAIN A CURRENT, COMPLETE, AND ACCURATE RECORD OF ALL CHANGES WHICH DEVIATE FROM THE CONSTRUCTION AS PROPOSED IN THESE PLANS AND SPECIFICATIONS FOR THE PURPOSE OF PROVIDING THE DESIGN ENGINEER WITH A BASIS FOR RECORD DRAWINGS. NO CHANGES SHALL BE MADE WITHOUT PRIOR APPROVAL OF THE DESIGN ENGINEER AND THE OWNER.
- 5. UPON COMPLETION OF THE PROJECT THE CONTRACTOR IS REQUIRED TO PROVIDE AS BUILT PLANS TO THE CITY OF COALINGA.
- 6. IN THE EVENT THAT THE CONTRACTOR NOTICES IRREGULARITIES IN THE LINE OR GRADE HE SHALL BRING IT TO THE IMMEDIATE ATTENTION OF THE DESIGN ENGINEER AND THE CITY'S REPRESENTATIVE. IF HE FAILS TO DO SO. THE CONTRACTOR SHALL BE RESPONSIBLE FOR ANY ERROR IN THE GRADE AND NECESSARY RECONSTRUCTION TO CORRECT SUCH ERROR.
- 7. AN EFFORT HAS BEEN MADE TO DEFINE THE LOCATION OF UNDERGROUND FACILITIES WITHIN THE JOB SITE. HOWEVER, ALL EXISTING UTILITY AND OTHER UNDERGROUND STRUCTURES MAY NOT BE SHOWN ON THIS PLAN AND THEIR LOCATION WHERE SHOWN IS APPROXIMATE. CONSTRUCTION CONTRACTOR SHALL ASSUME SOLE AND COMPLETE RESPONSIBILITY FOR LOCATING OR HAVING LOCATED ALL UNDERGROUND UTILITIES AND RELATED FACILITIES AND FOR PROTECTING SAME DURING THE COURSE OF CONSTRUCTION. CONTACT UNDERGROUND SERVICE ALERT (U.S.A.) AT 811, TWO WORKING DAYS PRIOR TO THE START OF CONSTRUCTION FOR ASSISTANCE FROM THE RESPECTIVE UTILITIES. ALL UTILITIES NOT A MEMBER OF U.S.A. MUST ALSO BE NOTIFIED.
- 8. THE CONTRACTOR AGREES THAT IN ACCORDANCE WITH GENERALLY ACCEPTED CONSTRUCTION PRACTICES THE CONTRACTOR SHALL BE REQUIRED TO ASSUME SOLE AND COMPLETE RESPONSIBILITY FOR THE CONDITION OF THE JOBSITE DURING THE COURSE OF CONSTRUCTION FOR THIS PROJECT, INCLUDING THE SAFETY OF ALL PERSONS AND PROPERTY, AND THAT THIS REQUIREMENT SHALL BE MADE TO APPLY CONTINUOUSLY AND NOT BE LIMITED TO NORMAL WORKING HOURS. THE CONTRACTOR FURTHER AGREES TO DEFEND, INDEMNIFY AND HOLD HARMLESS THE CITY OF COALINGA AND THE DESIGN PROFESSIONAL FROM ANY AND ALL LIABILITY, REAL OR ALLEGED IN CONNECTION WITH THE PERFORMANCE OF WORK ON THE PROJECT, EXCEPTING LIABILITY ARISING FROM NEGLIGENCE OF THE DESIGN PROFESSIONAL.
- 9. THE CITY'S REPRESENTATIVE ACTING ON BEHALF OF THE CITY PUBLIC WORKS DEPARTMENT MAY REQUIRE REVISIONS IN THE PLANS TO SOLVE UNFORESEEN PROBLEMS THAT MAY ARISE IN THE FIELD. ALL REVISIONS SHALL BE SUBJECT TO THE APPROVAL OF THE DESIGN ENGINEER
- 10. ANY DIRT OR DEBRIS TRACKED ONTO ANY CITY STREET FROM THIS PROJECT SHALL BE CLEANED OFF AT THE END OF EACH WORKING DAY TO THE SATISFACTION OF THE CITY'S REPRESENTATIVE.
- 11. ANY EXISTING SECTION CORNER OR PROPERTY CORNER MONUMENTS DAMAGED BY THESE IMPROVEMENTS SHALL BE RESET TO THE SATISFACTION OF THE CITY'S REPRESENTATIVE.
- 13. DURING THE CONSTRUCTION OF THIS PROJECT, ALLEY OR PUBLIC STREET SHALL NOT BE USED AS A STORAGE AREA FOR EQUIPMENT, MATERIALS, OR OTHER ITEMS.
- 16. CONSTRUCTION CONTRACTOR SHALL ASSUME SOLE AND COMPLETE RESPONSIBILITY FOR PROTECTION OF PUBLIC AND PRIVATE PROPERTY ADJACENT TO THE SITE AND THAT HE SHALL, AT HIS EXPENSE. REPAIR OR REPLACE TO ORIGINAL CONDITION ALL EXISTING IMPROVEMENTS WITHIN OR ADJACENT TO THE JOB SITE WHICH ARE NOT DESIGNATED FOR REMOVAL AND WHICH ARE DAMAGED OR REMOVED AS A RESULT OF HIS OPERATIONS.
- 17. THE CONTRACTOR SHALL OBTAIN WRITTEN AUTHORIZATION FROM ANY ADJACENT PROPERTY OWNER GIVING HIM PERMISSION TO ENTER HIS PROPERTY FOR PURPOSES OF CONSTRUCTION OF THE IMPROVEMENTS DELINEATED ON THESE PLANS AND TRANSITIONS HEREIN. THE CONTRACTOR SHALL PROVIDE THE CITY WITH THE COPY PRIOR TO THE COMMENCEMENT OF WORK.
- 18. THE CONTRACTOR SHALL EMPLOY ALL LABOR, EQUIPMENT AND METHODS REQUIRED TO PREVENT HIS OPERATION FROM PRODUCING DUST IN AMOUNTS DAMAGING TO PROPERTY AND DOMESTIC ANIMALS OR CAUSING A NUISANCE TO PERSONS OCCUPYING BUILDINGS IN THE VICINITY OF THE JOBSITE. THE CONTRACTOR SHALL BE RESPONSIBLE FOR ANY DAMAGE CAUSED BY DUST RESULTING FROM HIS OPERATIONS. THE CONTRACTOR SHALL ARRANGE FOR CITY WATER IF REQUIRED. DUST ABATEMENT MEASURES SHALL BE CONSISTENT WITH THE STANDARDS OF THE REGIONAL AIR QUALITY CONTROL BOARD AND SHALL BE CONTINUED UNTIL RELIEF IS GRANTED BY THE CITY'S REPRESENTATIVE.




TOTAL PIP DEPTH (TOP COURSE + WEAR COURSE)






POURED-IN-PLACE RUBBER SURFACING
