

RESOLUTION NO. 4345

**A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF COALINGA
OPTING OUT OF THE FRESNO COUNTY URBAN COUNTY CDBG PROGRAM FOR
PROGRAM YEARS: 2027, 2028, and 2029**

WHEREAS, every three (3) years the County of Fresno and its partner cities must re-qualify for Urban County entitlement status with the U. S. Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD) in order to receive entitlement grant funds for Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) and Home Investment Partnerships Act (HOME) for a new three (3) year period; and

WHEREAS, cities within Fresno County wishing to participate with the County in the Urban County Entitlement Program must enter into a cooperative agreement with the County and all other County cities via a Joint Powers Agreement (JPA) for the next three (3) year funding cycle beginning July 1, 2026 and ending June 30, 2029; and

WHEREAS, the County has asked all County cities to reply by July 8, 2026, with a minute motion or resolution indicating their choice to be a part of, or not be a part of, the next three (3) year Urban County CDBG Program beginning July 1, 2026; and

WHEREAS, the City of Coalinga, when it has participated in the Urban County Programs in the past, received on average approximately \$160,000 per year for CDBG and HOME eligible projects; and

WHEREAS, the City of Coalinga has chosen to opt “out” of the current Urban County Program and compete for Federal CDBG and HOME funding at the State level; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of Coalinga as follows:

The City of Coalinga will remain out of Fresno County's Urban County Community Development Block Grant Program for Federal Fiscal Years (FFY) 2027, 2028, and 2029.
